



Amsterdam (2) Berlin (2) Prague (3N) & Budapest(2N)

Day 1: Welcome to Amsterdam.

On arrival at Amsterdam airport, after clearing your customs and immigration travel to your hotel. Check in to your hotel and rest of day at leisure. [Overnight stay at Amsterdam.](#)

Day 2: Amsterdam City Tour

Day 3: Departure from Amsterdam to Berlin (approx. 7 hours)

Day 4: Berlin: Small-Group Third Reich and Cold War Walking Tour

Day 5: Departure from Berlin to Prague (approx. 5 Hours)

After breakfast and check out, proceed to the Berlin train station for your onward train to Prague. On arrival in Prague, proceed to your hotel. After having checked in at your hotel, spend some time to relax or you can explore Prague on your own. [Overnight stay at Berlin.](#)

**Day 6: Full Day Prague Tour with Vltava River Cruise and Prague Castle**

Meet in central Prague and embark on a panoramic bus tour of the city's sights. Pass the National Theater, Wenceslas Square, and other sights, and take a guided walk around UNESCO-listed Prague Castle to see its walls and learn about its glorious past. After a 3-course lunch at a nearby restaurant, visit the Italian-style Valdstejn Garden adjoining the 17th-century Valdstejn Palace and stroll through the elegant Mala Strana district. Continue to Kampa Island, home of the Lennon Wall, and then take a cruise down the Vltava River, passing sights like Charles Bridge.

Day 7: City walk, boat tour and typical Czech lunch

See all of Prague's top sights in a single day on this tour, which takes you from Charles Bridge to Prague Castle to Old Town, Lesser Town and the Jewish Quarter, while learning about the city's fascinating history. After lunch at a hand-picked Czech restaurant, see Prague's medieval landscape from a



different perspective on a 1-hour cruise down the Vltava River. (Lunch is not included). Overnight stay in Prague.

Day 8: Departure from Prague to Budapest (Approx. 8 Hours)

After breakfast and check out, proceed to the Prague train station for your onward train to Budapest. On arrival, proceed to your hotel. After having checked in at your hotel, spend some time to relax or you can explore the city on your own. [Overnight stay at Budapest.](#)

Day 9: Lake Balaton and Herend 9-Hour Tour from Budapest

This 9-hour tour from Budapest takes you on a discovery of Herend and Lake Balaton. You first head to Herend, where you will visit the world's largest porcelain manufacture, founded in 1826. After a guided tour through the rooms you'll be treated to a coffee and can choose to go shopping.

Next you will drive to Lake Balaton, the largest freshwater lake in Central Europe, and see the abbey founded in 1055 on the Tihany Peninsula. After a lunch break and some leisure time you'll go to Balatonfüred, home to the oldest spa in Hungary, where you can walk along the famous promenade. At the end of the tour you'll return to Budapest.

Day 10: Fly back home with pleasant memories: Proceed to the Airport for your flight back home.
